Strict adherence to the following final exam guidelines is expected. Any exceptions require the approval of an administrator.

- Fall semester examinations shall be a maximum of two hours. All courses for credit at CHS will have final examinations with the exception of courses for which an EOCT is administered (Economics). In these courses a gradable experience will be given.
- **NO check-outs** during examination periods. Students must remain in the classroom during examinations. Students should use the restroom prior to examinations and should request restroom access during an exam only in serious need.
- **FINAL EXAM MAKE-UP POLICY:**
 1. **NO EARLY FINAL EXAMS – NO EXCEPTIONS**
 2. All requests for excused absences must be submitted to the principal in writing prior to the week of final exams.
 3. A student has up to 10 days from the start of the second semester to make up a missed final exam. *It is the student's responsibility to schedule an appointment with the teacher to take the exam.*
 4. **Approved Excused Absence:**
 - a. Student will receive a 0 on the exam
 - b. The 0 will be calculated into the final semester grade
 - c. Student makes up exam
 - d. There will be no grade deduction taken for the absence.
 5. **Unexcused absence:**
 - a. Student will receive a 0 on the exam
 - b. The 0 will be calculated into the final semester grade
 - c. Student makes up exam
 - d. There will be a 10 point grade deduction taken from the exam grade

*All students who have lunch during the first exam period must report to the cafeteria or media center for a study hall. Students with their own transportation may arrive 15 minutes prior to their exam if they have lunch during the first exam period.
